



OVERVIEW

- Chem Chem Safaris consists of two leading luxury eco-properties: Chem Chem Lodge & Little Chem Chem.
- 20,000ha of private land within the Burunge Wildlife Management Area between the Tarangire National Park in the east and Lake Manyara in the west.
- Privately owned & managed by Fabia Bausch & Nicolas Negre who host their guests personally.
- The concept of “Slow Safari” was born at Chem Chem Lodge. The ethos of a safari being a tangible, sensual experience beyond the confines of a vehicle.
- The camps combine perfectly together creating an in-depth understanding of this diverse area, both within their own reserve and the surrounding National Parks underpinned with genuine Maasai experiences, but can also be booked separately.

LOCATION

CHEM CHEM LODGE

Chem Chem Lodge is situated on the edge of Lake Manyara in a 4’00ha private wildlife conservation area.

LITTLE CHEM CHEM

Little Chem Chem borders Tarangire National Park with its baobabs, overlooking Lake Burunge in a 16’000ha private wildlife concession

ACCESS

BY AIR:

The closest international airport is *Kilimanjaro* (3½ hour drive).

Arusha Airport and *Manyara Airstrip* are both a 90-minute drive to Chem Chem Lodge and Little Chem Chem.

Kilimanjaro Airport to *Arusha Airport*: 1.5 hours by road transfer.

Kuro Airstrip is a beautiful 4x4 safari transfer from within the Tarangire NP to Little Chem Chem and serviced by daily flights. Arrival into Kuro Airstrip flying out of Arusha: 20 minute flight.

BY ROAD :

RAINFALL Chem Chem is a relatively dry area and water can be scarce. Short rains are in November to early December, the long rains are from April to May. The long dry season is from June to November. Chem Chem Lodge is closed 1 April to 14 May. Little Chem Chem is closed 1 April to 31 May.

TRAVEL VISA Visas are required for most countries and can usually be obtained upon entry. Enquire ahead of time. Yellow fever certificate required and guests are asked to present this upon entering the country.

LIVEWILDLIFE's aim is environmental protection in rural Tanzania by assisting the communities in their present efforts to safeguard their surrounding wildlife and in the long run supporting the education system in cooperation with the local people, the teachers and state officials. In consultation with the appropriate authorities, LIVEWILDLIFE supports the state school infrastructure, offers courses for teachers and helps children to learn more about their local ecosystem through environmental education. LIVEWILDLIFE believes supporting education and protecting wildlife forms a perfect symbiosis, where Tanzanians determine their own land use, while the local ecosystem with its unique biodiversity stays in balance. LIVEWILDLIFE devote their work to the communities, especially to their children, towards a sustainable future. They also support the rangers employed by Chem Chem who protect the wildlife of the concession.

WILDLIFE CORRIDOR PROJECT: Chem Chem are currently working with the Wildlife Management Area to rescue to last wildlife corridor between Tarangire National Park and Manyara National Park. This is a hugely important project with the ever increasing influence of human impact on the natural movement of wildlife in the area. It involves working closely with and providing work for the villagers in the corridor, encouraging employment for women, game warden training etc. to ensure successful delivery of the project.
